Motion was seconded by Commissioner Tollison and was unanimously carried.

Commissioner Williams moved that the Water and Sewer Budget for fiscal year ending June 30, 1988, in the amount of \$4,589,029.00, be adopted. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Tollison and was carried by unanimous vote.

Commissioner Williams moved the adoption of the following resolution, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Morgan and was unanimously carried:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of the City of Brunswick that it hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute in behalf of the City Title III Contract between the Coastal Area Planning and Development Commission and the said City of Brunswick, said Contract, which extends from July 1, 1987, to June 30, 1988, to provide the sum of \$99,057.00 for use in the operation of the Community Development Multipurpose Center for the Elderly.

PRESENT: His Honor Mayor Paul Warwick, Jr., and Commissioners J. Calvin Morgan, James A. Stephens, Ken Tollison, and Thomas P. Williams.

His Honor the Mayor announced that this meeting had been called to consider important City business.

Commissioner Williams moved the adoption of the following resolution, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Stephens and was unanimously carried:

A RESOLUTION authorizing the Mayor of the City of Brunswick to act in behalf of the said City of Brunswick in all matters relating to the dividing of Service Delivery Area 10 into two areas; and for other purposes:

WHEREAS, the Private Industry Council and the Chief Elected Officials Group of Service Delivery Area (SDA) jointly administer the program operated under the Job Training Partnership Act in a fifteen (15) county area; and

WHEREAS, the large size of this area coupled with the economic diversity between the Coastal and Georgia Southern portion of this SDA is impeding the effective delivery of job training services; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor as its Chief Elected Official and representing this unit of local government, has certain responsibilities as outlined in Public Law 97-300, the Job Training Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commission of the City of Brunswick that the Mayor be, and hereby is, authorized to act for this government in all matters related to the dividing of SDA 10 into two areas; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized and instructed to transmit a copy of this resolution to the Private Industry Council, the Chief Elected Officials Group of SDA 10, and the Georgia Department of Labor.
