**DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**

Commissioner Credle moved that Paul Warwick, Jr., be appointed to the Downtown Development Authority to fill the unexpired term of Stuart Mitchell resigned until May 6, 1991. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Stephens and was unanimously carried.

**STREET PAVING**

The City Manager recommended that City pave Newcastle Street Lane at a cost of \$4,200.00. He stated that the cost of street paving will come from the local options sales tax fund, and that the City will be reimbursed for the said amount. Commissioner Stephens moved that the

City pave Newcastle Street Lane at a cost of \$4,200.00 and that said amount be reimbursed from the local option sales tax fund. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Credle and was unanimously carried.
