

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK, GEORGIA
RECESSED MEETING
6:00 P. M. MAY 17, 1990**

PRESENT: His Honor Mayor Homer L. Wilson, Commissioners James A. Stephens,
Thomas P. Williams, Ken Tollison
and Larry Credle.

INVOCATION: The invocation was given by Commissioner James A. Stephens.

PROPERTY INSURANCE BIDS

The Director of Finance submitted the following quotes received on renewing the City's property insurance: Shelander -Cowden \$63,169.00, Shelander-Cowden \$74,494.00, Trupp McGinty Ins. Co. \$51,278.00, Amer Mutual Fire Ins. \$53,291.00, Shelander-Cowden \$59,400.00. The Director of Finance stated that after reviewing bids for specifications he recommended the bid of Trupp McGinty-Hartford Steam Boiler Ins. Co., because all specifications were met. Mr. Shelander representing Shelander-Cowden was present to request that he would like the opportunity to change his bid to meet the specifications. Many questions were raised concerning meeting specifications, alternate bidding and changing an original bid. After a lengthy discussion Commissioner Stephens moved that the low bid of Trupp McGinty - Hartford Steam Boiler Ins. be accepted in the amount of \$54,270.00 which carries a \$5,000.00 deductible. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams. The motion carried by vote of 3 to 1 to O. Commissioners Stephens, Williams and Mayor Wilson voting Yes, Commissioner Credle voting No, and Commissioner Tollison abstaining.

DNR BUILDING

The Commission discussed the future Use of the Old DNR Building . It was recommended that the building be advertised for a long term lease, and repairs to be made by lessee. Commissioner Credle moved that the DNR Property be advertised for lease in three parcels as follows: (A) Montreal and Existing Dock (B) Concrete Building and Adjacent Dock and (C) Southern Building or a total of all three. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and was unanimously carried.

OTHER CITY BUSINESS

The Commission discussed a stop light at Hercules entrance on Stacy Street and resetting flashing light at Jane Macon Middle School.

Commissioner Williams moved that four way stop signs be placed at Monck and Stonewall Streets because of increased traffic, subject to the City Manager notifying neighbors. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Credle and was carried by vote of 4 to 1 Commissioner Tollison voting No.

The Commission with high words of praise thanked Richard Crowdis, outgoing City Manager for 2 years of outstanding administration in the City of Brunswick. Received with appreciation.
