ADOPTION OF BOND RESOLUTION

Commissioner Stephens moved that the following Resolution to provide for the Issuance of the Series 1990 Bond be approved. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Williams and was unanimously carried: (Bond Resolution)

BILLBOARD ORDINANCE

Ed Stelle, Glynn County Director of Community Development was present to request that the Commission place a 90-day moratorium on the issuance of permits for the Erection and Installation of Billboards to allow for the formulation of a new ordinance.

Commissioner Credle moved issuance of the moratorium. Commissioner Williams seconded motion. On call for the question the motion carried by vote of 4 to 1. Commissioner Tollison voting No.

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE A MORATORIUM ON
THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, ERECTION OR
INSTALLATION OF BILLBOARDS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE;
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK hereby ordains:


Section 1. A moratorium is hereby imposed on the issuance of permits for the construction, erection or installation of billboards within the City of Brunswick.

Section 2. The term "BILLBOARD" as used herein shall mean any free-standing outdoor advertising structure which has a flat surface sign space upon which advertising may be

posted, painted or affixed and which is primarily designed for the rental or lease of such sign space for advertising not related to the use of the property on which the structure exists.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become of full force and effect immediately upon its adoption on November 19, 1990, shall continue in effect through February 6, 1991, unless sooner repealed, and shall expire and become null and void as of February 7, 1991.
