

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
COMMISSION MEETING OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK, GEORGIA
RECESSED MEETING
7:00 P.M., NOVEMBER 26, 1991**

PRESENT: His Honor Mayor Homer L. Wilson, Commissioners Otis Herrington and Roosevelt Lawrence.

ABSENT: Commissioner James A. Stephens.

INVOCATION: The invocation was given by Commissioner Otis Herrington.

The City Manager updated the Commission on the water and wastewater study that was conducted by Dan Altobelli and Associates. Local Industry Representatives, including the Brunswick-Golden Isles Chamber of Commerce were present to request that the Commission reconsider the rate increase. Mr. Altobelli stated that the study of the new user fees and new rates represents the actual cost of operating the City's Water and Wastewater Treatment Plant. Commissioner Herrington moved that the ordinance revising the rates, fees and charges for sewer service be approved. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Lawrence and was unanimously carried.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BRUNSWICK CODE SO AS TO REVISE THE RATES, FEES AND CHARGES FOR SEWERAGE SERVICE; TO AMEND SECTION 22-19 OF THE BRUNSWICK CODE PERTAINING TO THE USER CHARGE SYSTEM; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Section 1. The Code of the City of Brunswick, Georgia, is hereby amended by striking from subsection (a) of Section 22-19 the following sentence:

and by inserting the following new sentence in lieu thereof:

"The calculation procedures for these charges are more particularly described in a report entitled "user Charge System for Wastewater Facilities of the City of Brunswick" prepared by Wiedeman and Singleton, Inc., engineers, revised July 15, 1982, and in a report updating the same, entitled "User Charge Study for Wastewater Facilities, City of Brunswick," prepared by Moreland Altobelli Associates, Inc., engineers, dated November 25, 1991."

Section 2. The Brunswick Code is hereby further amended by striking in its entirety subsection (f) of Section 22-19 and by substituting in lieu thereof a new subsection (f) which shall provide as follows:

- (f) The EPA user charge, which includes charges for operation, maintenance and replacement cost, will be assessed for all contributors to the treatment works on the following basis:
 - (1) A charge for administrative costs plus cost of operation, maintenance and replacement shall be assessed against each customer per month in the amount of \$1.60 plus \$1.68 per thousand gallons of flow. The charge shall consist of \$0.870 for operation, maintenance and replacement cost of the Academy
