

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
COMMISSION MEETING OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK, GEORGIA
REGULAR MEETING
2:00 P. M., May 2, 1994**

PRESENT: His Honor Mayor Homer L. Wilson, Commissioners Roosevelt Lawrence,
Doris A. Davis and Dr. James MacLeod.

INVOCATION: The invocation was given by Commissioner Dr. James MacLeod.

Mayor Wilson announced that this meeting has been called in order that the City Manager may release the name of the person he will recommend for Police Chief.

The City Manager stated that over the past several months the City has conducted an exhausted search process for a Police Chief that resulted in the City receiving more than 50 applicants for the position. The group was narrowed down to three finalist and the Commission had an opportunity to meet and talk with them. Each of these men are qualified and certainly have a lot to offer the Police Department, however only one person can be selected. The City Manager further stated that in accordance with the Charter of the City of Brunswick he nominated an individual that has served the City of Brunswick and the Brunswick Police Department well for 25 years. A person that he has selected twice to serve as interim Chief and who has performed admirably in that capacity. The City Manager respectfully requested the Commission's confirmation of Major T.C. Cowan as Chief of the Brunswick Police Department.

Commissioner Lawrence moved and Commissioner MacLeod seconded the motion to hold an Executive Session. The motion passed unanimously.

Following the Executive Session Commissioner Davis moved and Commissioner MacLeod seconded the motion to accept the City Manager's recommendation of Major T. C. Cowan as the Police Chief of the City of Brunswick. The motion was passed unanimously.
