

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK, GEORGIA
CALLED MEETING
10:00 A.M., APRIL 29, 1997**

PRESENT: His Honor, Mayor Homer L. Wilson, Commissioner Lawrence, Dr. James MacLeod, Ken Plyman and Harold E. Jennings.

INVOCATION: Commissioner MacLeod gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Mayor, Commissioners and everyone recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPOINTMENT OF INTERIM WATERFRONT MANAGER: Commissioner MacLeod made the motion that the City Manager, Mark Mitchell be appointed as Interim Waterfront Manager for a period of six months. Commissioner Plyman seconded. Mayor Wilson called for discussion.

Bob Chaney, Chairperson, Downtown Development Authority, appeared before the Commission to address the budget proposal the DDA made to the City to manage the Waterfront. He stated that the DDA would be back in six months to once again make a proposal to the Commission, but in the meantime, he wanted to offer the DDA's services to help the City Manager anyway they could.

Mayor Wilson explained the importance of appointing an Interim Manager was for the Farmer's Market to be up and operating on time. He stated he thought six months was too long to have an Interim Manager, that three months would have been long enough.

Mayor Wilson called for the vote. Motion passed four to one with all Commissioners voting unanimously. Mayor Wilson abstained because he did not agree to the six months period.
