

OFFICIAL MINUTES
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRNSWICK, GEORGIA
REGULAR MEETING
7:00 P.M., OCTOBER 20, 1999

PRESENT: His Honor Mayor Bradford S. Brown, Commissioners Roosevelt Lawrence, Harold E. Jennings, Jonathan Williams and Doris A. Davis.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Harold E. Jennings gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Pledge of allegiance was recited by everyone in attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Williams seconded the motion approving the minutes of the rescheduled meeting of September 29, 1999 and the rescheduled meeting of October 4, 1999. The motion carried.

RECOGNITIONS: Mayor Brown presented a plaque to Rich Sea Pak for their generous donation of the Musical Playscape in Mary Ross Waterfront Park. Jean Alden representative from Rich Sea Pak thanked the Commission for the plaque.

Mayor Brown presented a proclamation to the YWCA recognizing October 17-23, 1999 as Week Without Violence.

Mayor Brown presented a proclamation proclaiming Sunday October 31, 1999 as Jeanyne Carmouche Day in the City of Brunswick. Mrs. Carmouche was not present to accept the proclamation. Mr. Ed Lowe accepted the proclamation for her.

Mayor Brown presented a proclamation to Root Communications thanking them for an outstanding job in broadcasting the news during the threat of Hurricane Floyd.

APOINTMENTS: Census 2000 Complete Count Committee. There were no appointments made by the Commission.

APPROVALS: Petition received from Eddie L. Brown and Daniel Q. Tillman to retail beer and wine for consumption on premises at 3302 Glynn Avenue. Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Jennings seconded the motion granting the alcoholic beverage license. The motion carried.

MONTHLY REPORTS: The following reports for the month of September were submitted and were filed as information:

Commissioner Davis made the motion and Commissioner Lawrence seconded the motion to accept the monthly reports. The motion carried.

CITY MANAGER'S ITEMS: The City Manager stated that a copy of the project schedule for Asbestos Abatement and Lead Based Paint Mitigation was submitted to the Commission.

Douglas Neill was present to answer questions concerning Asbestos Abatement and Lead Based Paint Mitigation. He gave an overview of Asbestos Abatement and Lead Based Paint Mitigation. He stated that the City will receive bids on November 2, 1999.

The City Manager stated that the Municipal Court has moved completely out of the building. Municipal Court is held in the new Courthouse.

CITY ATTORNEY ITEM: The City Attorney stated that the new franchise agreement is in final form and requested that the Commission approve it.

Commissioner Lawrence moved and Commissioner Davis seconded the motion authorizing the Mayor to execute the final franchise agreement, subject to Georgia Municipal Association and the City Attorney giving final approval. The motion carried.

MAYOR'S ITEM: Mayor Brown requested that the City declare Veteran's Day November 11, 1999 as a Holiday for City employees.

Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Jennings seconded the motion declaring Veteran's Day November 11th as a permanent holiday for City employees. The motion carried.

Mayor Brown announced that a Brunswick Stew Cook Off will be held on October 23, 1999. He invited everyone to attend the Stew Cook Off at the Mary Ross Waterfront Park.

MAYOR PRO TEM ITEM: Commissioner Lawrence stated that he will discuss his personnel issue at the next meeting.
