

**OFFICIAL MINUTES
COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRNSWICK, GEORGIA
CALLED MEETING
10:30 A.M., NOVEMBER 09, 1999**

PRESENT: His Honor Mayor Bradford S. Brown, Commissioners Roosevelt Lawrence, Harold E. Jennings, Jonathan Williams and Doris A. Davis.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Harold E. Jennings gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Pledge of allegiance was recited by everyone in attendance.

Mayor Brown announced that this meeting was called to set the millage rate for the 1999 Real Estate and Personal property taxes.

The Director of Finance gave a five year history of levy on the taxes. He explained the calculated millage rate which will be set at 11 mills.

Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Davis seconded the motion approving January 30, 2000 as the due date for City Taxes. The motion carried.

Commissioner Jennings made the motion and Commissioner Lawrence seconded the motion unanimously adopting the following resolution:

**AD VALOREM TAX MILLAGE RATE RESOLUTION
CITY OF BRUNSWICK**

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Brunswick that an ad valorem tax of thirty-four dollars and fifty seven cents (\$34.57) per one thousand dollars (\$1000.00) of assessed valuation is hereby levied and assessed for the calendar year 1999 upon all tangible property that is subject to taxation within the City. Pursuant to Official Code of Georgia Annotated Section 48-8-91, it is further resolved that said millage rate of thirty-four and fifty-seven one hundredths (34.57) mils shall be reduced by twenty-three and fifty-seven one hundredth (23.57) mils, that being the millage rate which, if levied against the tangible property in the City of Brunswick, would produce an amount equal to the distribution of local option sales tax received by the City of Brunswick during 1998, leaving a net millage rate of eleven and zero one hundredths (11.00) mils, which shall be the net millage rate upon which each taxpayer's bill shall be based. It is further resolved that payment of 1999 ad valorem taxes shall be due no later than January 30, 2000.
