

**OFFICIAL MINUTES

**INVOCATION:** Commissioner Harold E. Jennings gave the invocation.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by everyone in attendance.

**MINUTES:** Mayor Brown announced that this meeting was called to discuss a relocation site for City Hall employees during the renovation process of City Hall.

The City Manager told the Commission that he looked at several buildings located within the City as a possible relocation site. He pointed out that many buildings had no office space and inadequate parking for City employees.

Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Jennings seconded the motion to hold an Executive Session to discuss future acquisition of real estate. The motion carried.

Following the Executive Session Mayor Brown stated that the list of properties for relocation have been narrowed down to a few properties. The City Manager was instructed to go to each property owner and get a price and cost estimate.

Mayor Brown pointed out that the Commission did not want to discuss the location of these properties.

Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Jennings seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried.
