COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK, GEORGIA
CALLED MEETING

3:00 P.M. MAY 29, 2001

PRESENT: His Honor Mayor Bradford S. Brown, Commissioners Roosevelt Lawrence, Harold E. Jennings, Jonathan Williams and Doris A. Davis.

ABSENT: Commissioners Roosevelt Lawrence.

INVOCATION: Commissioner Jennings gave the invocation.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by everyone in attendance.

DISCUSSION:

Howard Coffin Pool.

Reginald Jackson, Recreation Director was present to discuss the condition of the pool at Howard Coffin Park. The Recreation Director stated that the pool was sixty-years old and constructed during World War II for military personnel working near the docks. He pointed out that cracks in the pool keep appearing every year. The pool has shifted and is unlevelled. The Deck area is not sufficient and the swimming pool violates the state law. The law states that no one should enter a pool at the deep end.

Following a lengthy discussion Commissioner Jennings made the motion authorizing the Recreation Director to transport kids to the Selden Park Pool and get a signed letter from parents authorizing their children to be transported and advertise in the Brunswick News the closing of the pool. Commissioner Davis seconded the motion. The motion passed.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Jennings seconded the motion to hold an Executive Session to discuss a legal matter. The motion passed.

Following the Executive Session, Commissioner Lawrence made the motion and Commissioner Davis seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. All voted by standing.
