ITEMS (S) FOR APPROVAL

Repaving of two (2) Streets in various locations. (D. McFee)

Dan McFee, City Engineer, requested approval for the repaving of two streets in various locations. He recommended the low bid of Allen Owens, Inc., for the amount of \$66,824.00.

Commissioner Brooks made a motion and Mayor Pro-Tem Spaulding seconded the motion authorizing the City Manager and the City Attorney to sign contract for the repaving of two (2) streets in various locations; namely entrance into the newly built Glynn Middle School and a section of Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard from the end of the pavement to a point 50 feet south of Second Avenue and also the paving of "S" Street from Reynolds Street to Newcastle Street. The motion passed unanimously by a vote of 4 to 0.
