- A. The City of Brunswick is reallocating the 2012 Rehabilitation funds for the 2013 fiscal year to be used to fund the Liberty Ship Trail which will provide a multi-use bike/pedestrian path to connect Fourth Avenue with Sidney Lanier Park. The trail will connect to the existing sidewalk/bike path by connecting the park from Fourth Avenue to Howard Coffin Park.
- B. The City of Brunswick Department of Community Development is reallocating funds from the 2012 Rehabilitation Program to fund the Roosevelt Lawrence Equipment Project. The funds will be provided to fund the apparatus equipment for the youth attending the after school and summer camp programs.
