COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM**

The City of Brunswick will be receiving approximately \$336,421 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development beginning in fiscal year 2016.

As allowed by the federal regulations, the City of Brunswick will allocate a portion of its annual CDBG funds to assist non-profit organizations that provide health and human services. CDBG Public Service funds may be used for operating costs for a wide variety of public services that benefit low income citizens or special need populations, including but not limited to, childcare, healthcare, job training, recreation programs, education programs, public safety services, fair housing activities, services for elderly, homeless, homeless person with HIV/AIDS, disabled persons and drug abuse counseling and treatment.

Information regarding the eligible uses of the funds and technical assistance to complete the grant applications will be provided. The workshop/public hearings will be held on the following date, time, and location in Brunswick:

Nonprofit organizations that wish to apply for these funds MUST ATTEND the appropriate MANDATORY workshop in order to receive an application and apply for this funding. It is highly encouraged that the person(s) writing the grant and a board member attend this workshop. Applications submitted by organizations that do not attend this workshop will not be accepted by the City of Brunswick.
