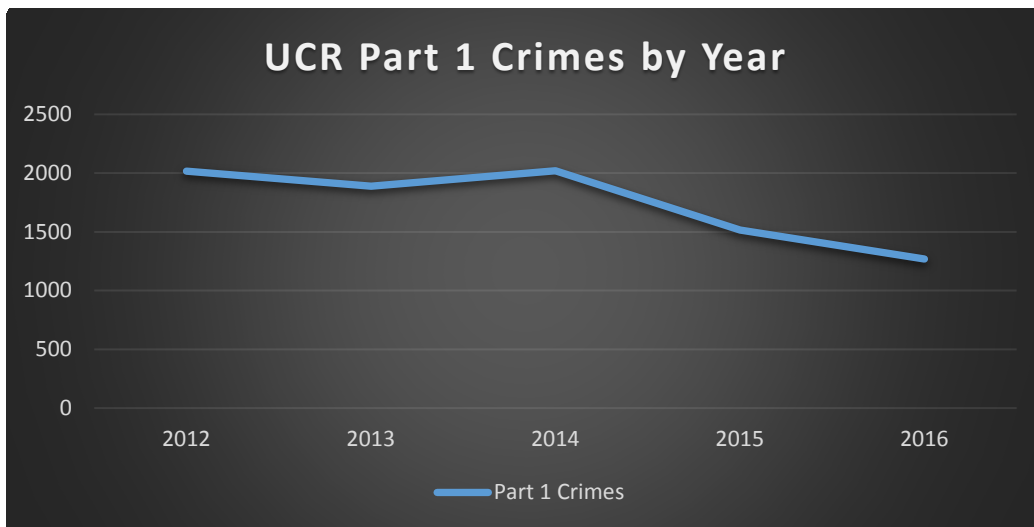


UNIFORM CRIME REPORTING (UCR)

The FBI's UCR Program is a nationwide, cooperative effort of over 18,000 law enforcement agencies voluntarily reporting data on crimes brought to their attention and is the benchmark used by the department to gauge progress in our efforts to decrease crime in our city. UCR Part 1 Crimes cover the majority of crime that happens in our city with the exception of drug activity.

- Brunswick has had a decrease in reported crime seven of the last eight years-every year since 2009-with the exception of 2014. There have been decreases of 5% or higher in six of those years.
- Overall, for the year 2016, there was a 16% decrease in the number of reported Part 1 Crimes. There were 1,270 offenses reported in 2016 and 1,515 reported in 2015 for a difference of -245. There was a 25% decrease for 2015.

- For 2016, violent crimes (homicide/rape/robbery/aggravated assault) decreased 11% over 2015 while property crimes (burglary/larceny/vehicle theft) decreased 19% in the same period.
