



NOTICE OF SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT 2014 - 2018 Annual Action Plan

Notice is hereby given that the City of Brunswick Department of Economic and Community Development has available for review the amended 2018 Annual Action Plan as required by the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development that includes changes to earlier years as well. The change was previously advertised on January 14, 2019.

However, due to federal requirements, the location of the sidewalks have to be changed. The new locations are:

- Gordon St. - L to O
- O St. – Union to Amherst
- Union St. - R to S
- Ellis St. - O to T
- Q St. - Reynolds t Ellis
- R St. – Reynolds to Ellis

Available funding may not address all these streets in the first year.

The public is strongly encouraged to review the Annual Action Plan and Consolidated Plan Amendment and provide input and comments on these important issues of the city.
