## **RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-02**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BRUNSWICK REQUESTING GLYNN COUNTY COMMENCE THE PROCESS TO IMPOSE A ONE PERCENT SALES TAX AND USE; AND REQUESTING THE CALL FOR AN ELECTION OF THE VOTERS OF GLYNN COUNTY TO APPROVE THE IMPOSITION OF SUCH TAX; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Article 3 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated (the "Act") authorizes a county to enact the imposition of a one percent sales and use tax ("SPLOST") for the purpose, inter alia, of financing certain capital outlay projects identified by the county and any qualified municipalities located therein; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brunswick, Georgia, (the "City") being the only qualified municipality located within Glynn County, has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City to request that Glynn County pass a resolution to lawfully impose a SPLOST to assist in the funding of capital outlay projects identified by the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Georgia law, the City of Brunswick Mayor and Board of Commissioners met jointly with the Glynn County Board of Commissioners on December 1, 2020 and January 5, 2021 to discuss the imposition of the SPLOST; and,

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Parties that the County call for a referendum to be placed on the ballot for the March 16, 2021 special election to be voted on by the citizens of Glynn County; and,

WHEREAS, it is also the consensus of the Parties to call for a three (3) year SPLOST;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners, acting in its capacity as the governing authority of the City of Brunswick, Georgia, that Glynn County pass a resolution imposing a one percent sales and use tax as authorized by Article 3 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated; specifying the purposes for which the proceeds of such tax are to be used; specifying the period of time for which such tax may be imposed; specifying the estimated cost of the facilities to be funded from the proceeds of such tax; requesting the election superintendent to call an election of the voters of Glynn County to approve the imposition of such sales and use tax; and approving the form of ballot to be used in such election.
